Resolution:

Government is pleased to direct that a fund to be designated as "Gujarat State Famine Relief Fund" should be constituted for the purpose of providing relief in areas affected by scarcity conditions in the State from time to time. Rules for the management of the Fund will be framed ~~by the Government~~ separately. A current account on behalf of this Fund should be opened in the State Bank of India, Sachivalaya, Branch, Ahmedabad, to which all donations to this Fund should be credited.

2. This Fund should be kept outside the Public Account of the State Government. All cheques on the banking account may be signed and all bills, notes, and other negotiable instruments may be drawn, accepted and made on behalf of the Gujarat State Famine Relief Fund by the Deputy Secretary to Government in Revenue Department who may be designated for this purpose.

3. Cheques, bills, notes and other negotiable instruments payable to this Fund may be endorsed for the said Fund by the same officer.

4. Donations received by the Collectors and by the Secretary to the Chief Minister should be remitted to the Deputy Secretary, Revenue Department for being credited in to the above mentioned account.
